2021 Open Enrollment for Kidspace Summer Camp:

Applications will be taken starting April 12, 2021 7:30 am- 1:30 pm. On April 12 5:30-7:30 pm you are welcome to come in and bring your campers application along with the \$50.00 registration fee. You can also drop applications off at the church office on Hilliard St. anytime Please place it in the lock box at the door.



Due to Covid-19 there are some changes to our Summer Camp.

We are excited to have your child join us for Kidspace Summer Camp. Thank you for supporting this ministry of our church. We pray your child will enjoy learning and "growing in the Son".

We will offer 5 days a week at \$120.00 per week. Payment will be due each Friday the week before camp. Our hours will be 7:30-6:00. If we are able to take field trips the cost will be added. This is the only option available for Summer Camp. Half-days or drop-ins are not an option this Summer.

Parents will remain in their vehicles at drop-off, which will take place in the drive through area. Temperatures will be taken before the camper exits the vehicle. Covid-19 questions will be asked. Please be aware due to possible Covid-19 exposures we may have to close camp. We are asking campers and staff to **wear mask** and wash hands frequently. We ask campers to arrive by 9:00 am each day. Staff will be at the door starting at 4:00 pm for pick up. You will have to call Denise Calloway or Melissa Lumpp for other drop off or pick up times.

Each camper will **bring their own lunch box and drink.** Two snacks will be provided. One in the morning and one in the afternoon. A list will be sent home and you will be encouraged to send something if your camper does not care for the snacks we have for that day.

We will have camp counselors that will play and engage with your camper along with fun activities planned each day. We will have a time of Bible Stories and singing of Praise and Worship music.

We are also asking campers with hair below the shoulders to be placed in a pony-tail. This is very helpful to prevent the spread of lice. There are also products available to help deter this issue. If your child is scratching their head, please check them thoroughly before coming to Summer Camp.

Campers may not attend camp with a fever over 99.5, or a runny nose with mucus of color, or vomiting or diarrhea. If your child has had an unusual cough, or shortness of breath, vomiting, diarrhea, fever over 99.5 or been around someone with Covid-19 symptoms they must stay at home for 10 days or a note from their Doctor clearing them for camp. This also means they must be symptom free for 24 hours without medication.

The children that sign up for Summer Camp must be able to care for themselves in the restroom and change clothes for water games or field trips which may require a bathing suit. The ages for Summer Camp are 5-10 years old and must be able to listen and follow directions. The Director or Assistant Camp Director may need to make decisions due to behavior for field trip attendance. This is for the safety of all campers. If or when a camper becomes disruptive the camper's parents will be contacted and this could result in *dismissal from the program after three incidents*.
